Nomination Form & Submission Guidelines

Selection principle: Induction is based on documented, sustained and significant contributions—not name recognition, company size, membership status or the number of nominations received. Multiple nominations do not increase a candidate's standing. Deadline for submissions is October 31, 2026.

Purpose and eligibility

The Decorative Concrete Hall of Fame recognizes individuals and companies whose work has produced a lasting and significant impact on the decorative concrete industry. Nominees must have at least **15 years of experience** in decorative concrete.

Submission requirements

- Complete the nominee and nominator information.
- Provide a concise Case for Induction of no more than 300 words.
- Select and address the nominee's three strongest contribution categories. Each response is limited to 200 words.
- Provide two independent references. Recommendation letters may be requested if the nominee advances.
- Limit supporting materials to 10 items or 20 pages total. Links may be used for videos or extensive portfolios.

Be specific, concise and evidence-based. The committee may request clarification or additional documentation.
